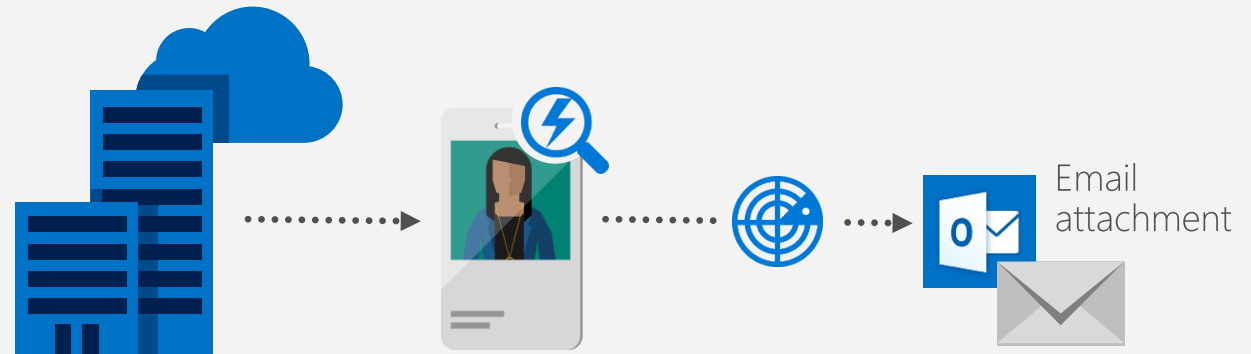
Microsoft Advanced Threat Analytics

On Premises Network

Benefits:

-Putting DCs and ADFS in Azure provide authentication redundancy. If your local AD is down, users can still authenticate to O365 for critical services like Email

Tips:

- Windows Server 2012 or later is required if running DCs in Server Virtualization
- Configure AD Sites link costs appropriately
- Azure DNS doesn't support AD, you need your own DNS presence in Azure
- Place the AD DIT/SYSVOL on non-cached data drive

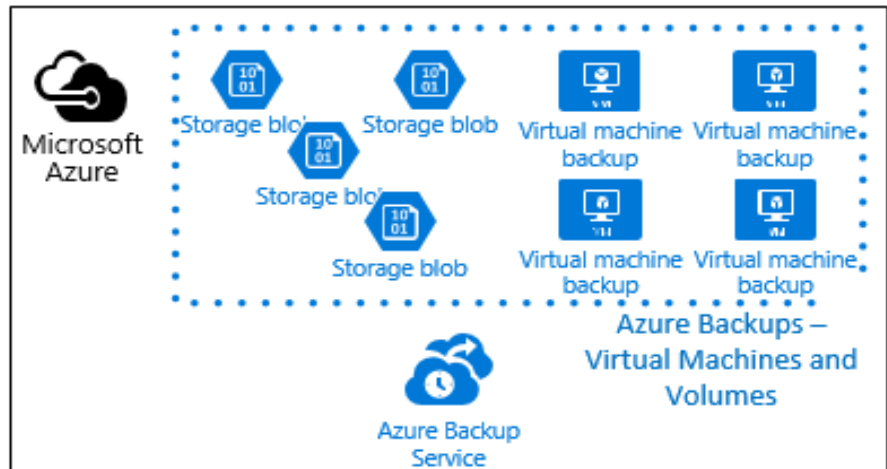

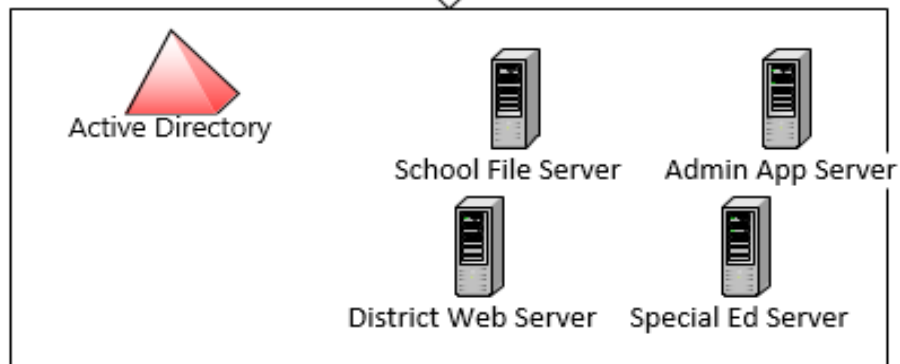
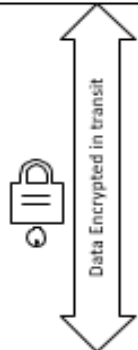

On Premises Network

Benefits:

- Azure backup is a compelling alternative to tape backups with significant cost savings, shorter recovery time and up to 99 years of retention.
- Backing up clients or servers to Azure is secure over the wire and at rest. Backups are stored in geo-replicated storage which maintains 6 copies of you data across two Azure datacenters.

Tips:

- Azure backup can back up physical servers and virtual machines both in the cloud and on premises.
- Use Data Protection Manager for multi-server or complex application workloads (E.g. Exchange, SharePoint, etc.)

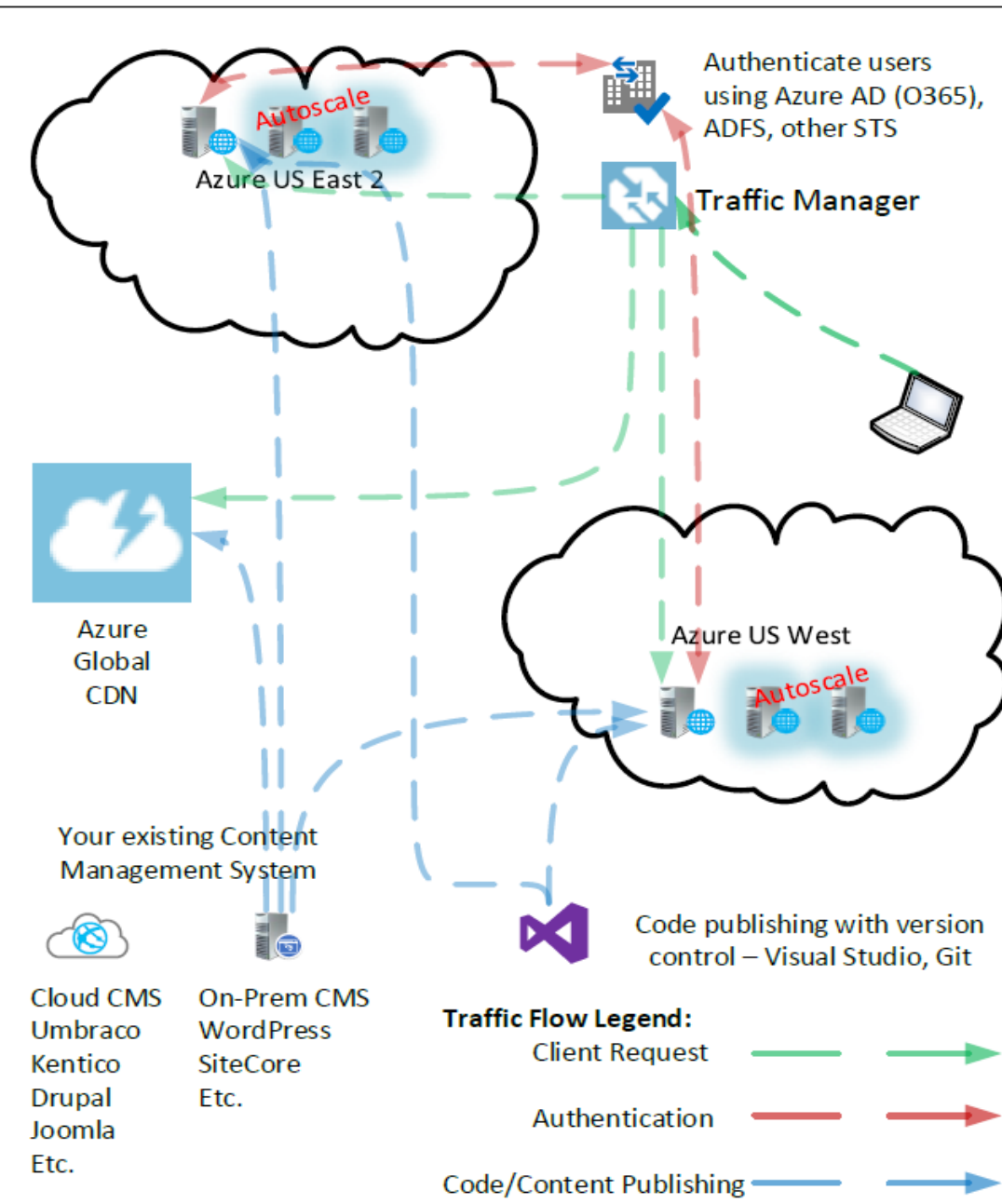

Your Public Web Site in Azure App Service



Benefits:

- You don't have to patch/upgrade OS, IIS, Java, .Net, etc.
- Multi-Geography, out of region infrastructure with lower maintenance/management overhead.
- Easy auto-scaling to handle peak loads (start/end of semester/year, athletic events, commencement, etc.)
- Integrate Azure Content Delivery Network (CDN) for audio, video, photos, etc.
- Cross-platform: ASP.Net, Java, Node.js, .Net, WordPress, C#, Python, PHP, HTML5
- User Auth – supports Azure AD (O365) as well as on-premises ADFS & other STS as well as multi-factor
- Secure – ISO, SOCS, PCI compliant
- Backups support built-in (consumes Azure Storage for backup retention)

Tips:

- Identify existing Content Management Service (CMS) – likely can publish to Azure Web Sites
- CDN raises performance for heavy media but adds some complexity – assess cost/benefit to your website
- Work with your CMS/Devs to agree on target URL's for Traffic Manager Health Probes
